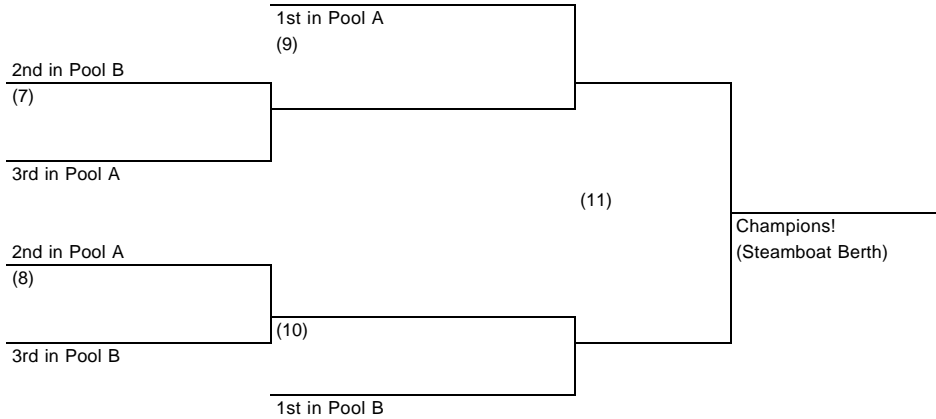

TRIPLE CROWN SEEDING RULES – First factor is Win-Loss record

Three Way Tie: Same Pool

1. Total run differential
2. Fewest runs allowed
3. Most runs scored
4. Coin toss

IMPORTANT: Run differential maximum

1. Forfeits will be scored 7-0
2. Maximum run spread per game is 7 regardless of score

TIE BREAKER SYSTEM:

If a game is tied after all innings have been completed (or at time limit), the California tie breaker rule will go into effect. Each team puts their last scheduled batter on second base and plays out the inning. This happens until the tie is broken and the game is complete.
